## Drug Impairment Training for Educational Professionals

The DITEP training is intended to make participants competent and confident in evaluating and documenting those individuals suspected of abusing drugs in the school setting.

- Day one is for ANYONE (affiliated with school) who interacts with students from bus drivers to high level administrators.
- Day two is best suited for those who will actually conduct the hands on evaluations, more likely school nurses and school resource officers. \*\*The ending time may be earlier depending on the number of participants.

*Participants MUST attend Day 1 in order to attend Day 2*
